DEPARTMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

All Monterey County 4-H, FFA, and Independent Livestock Exhibitors at the Monterey County Fair MUST enter at least one (1) non-livestock project for exhibit in the 4-H, FFA Divisions in the junior Buildings at this year's annual Fair. All non-livestock projects must be entered & delivered on their specific dates. NO LIVESTOCK PROJECTS WILL BE ACCEPTED IF THIS ABOVE RULE IS NOT MET. ANIMALS WILL BE SENT HOME. NO EXCEPTIONS. All other rules stated in the premium book apply. This does not apply to San Benito & Santa Cruz County exhibitors.

1. An AUCTION SALE OF MARKET LIVESTOCK will be held at the Monterey County Fairgrounds starting at 10:00 a.m., Saturday, August 15, 2009. Only animals exhibited at the Monterey County Fair in the Junior Livestock Departments will be eligible for sale.
2. The Monterey County Fair Junior Livestock Auction is a TERMINAL SALE, all Market Acceptable/Market Ready animals judged will be sold through the auction. Exception is Sale Lots of Rabbit and Poultry. Sale Lots must be removed by August 16, 2009 at 5:00 p.m.
3. All FFA exhibitors are required to wear FFA National (Official) Uniform. No black pants.
 - a. 4-H/Grange members please refer to Departmental Rules & Regulations for dress code requirements. No black pants.
 - b. The owner of the animals shall have his/her animal ready at the time of sale in order to be sold. No exceptions will be made except in extreme emergency. Arrangements must be with management prior to sale date.
 - c. All animals must be presented in Show Condition. Exhibitors CANNOT DECORATE THEIR ANIMALS, NO GLITTERS, etc.
4. No breeding stock or feeder animals will be sold through the auction ring.
5. An 8.0% selling charge will be collected on all livestock sold, and \$1.00 will be deducted from all market Beef sales for the California Beef Council. A .004% selling charge for Swine for Pork Promotion will also be charged.
6. A \$12.00 charge will be withheld from checks for all animals to cover cost of two (2) 5" x 7" color pictures taken of exhibitor and animals.
7. A JUNIOR LIVESTOCK EXHIBITOR MAY SHOW AND SELL ONE OR TWO MARKET BEEF OR ONE MARKET LAMB AND ONE BEEF OR ONE MARKET HOG AND ONE MARKET BEEF OR ONE SMALL MARKET ANIMAL ONLY.
8. Every Seller of livestock is REQUIRED to write a thank you letter to buyers of their animals. Any exhibitor not fulfilling this requirement is subject to being barred from selling at future sales of the Monterey County Fair Junior Livestock Auction. Leaders and Advisors may obtain stationery for writing thank you letters from the Livestock Office during the Fair. Distribution of stationery and pictures will be from the Livestock Office by members of the Auction Committee.
9. All market lambs must have been vaccinated for "OVEREATING DISEASE" prior to arrival at the Fair. The vaccine MUST NOT BE ADMINISTERED WITHIN 21 days of market. This

is best accomplished by vaccinating lambs, with Cloristridum Perfringens Type D Bacterin-Toxoid, at the time they are placed on food.

- a. With the passage of law AB489, the seller of animals, found to contain residues, is liable for triple civil damages plus attorney fees. Federal meat inspectors will be sampling show animals at the packing plants, looking for residues of antibiotics, tranquilizers and sedatives. Carcasses that are positive are condemned, and the F.D.A. and C.D.F.A. are notified so enforcement action can be taken.
 - b. It is extremely important that withdrawal periods be strictly complied with for all medications used in animals that are going to market. These withdrawal times and approved uses are listed on the labels of each medication. If a use or species is not found on the label, it is not legal for that purpose, and this particular medication should not be used.
 - c. Please be sure that each project member, under your leadership and their parents or guardians, are aware of this regulation so that inadvertent violations will not occur. If you have animal or drug treatment questions, you should consult your local veterinarian.
9. The Change of Ownership of any animal sold through the Auction does not change to buyer of said animal until the exhibitor is released from the Fairgrounds at 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 16, 2009. Any exhibitor dismissed from the Monterey County Fair for misconduct will forfeit payment if animal is sold through the Livestock Auction and buyer of that animal will be released from any obligation for payment. The offending exhibitor will not be allowed to enter or exhibit again at the Monterey County Fair.
10. For animals that are unfit for market or that expire after the auction, the owner/exhibitor of said animal will forfeit payment for animal and be required to return the check to Auction Chairman, and the buyer of the animal shall be released from any obligation.
11. More detailed information on the Auction will be available immediately prior to the date of the sale.
12. Any auction animal being resold for charity must be sold at the end of the auction. Arrangements must be made in advance.
13. All exhibitors of market animals must meet proof of ownership requirements as follows: BEEF - 120 days; SWINE, SHEEP AND GOATS - 60 days.
14. NOTE: Judge will be instructed to judge strictly on Grade Standards as outlined in the Premium Book.
15. IMPORTANT: All market animals are subject to inspection for drug residues. Animals containing unauthorized residues will be condemned and the parties responsible for these residues are subject to prosecution under the Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act.
16. It is mandatory that a "Certificate of Animal Medication" be completed for each market animal. This form is located in the rear of this book.
17. The Monterey County Fair Junior Livestock Auction Committee discourages exhibitors from giving alcohol as a buyer's gift. The Friends of Monterey County Fair will be selling gift certificates to give as a gift option.
18. IMPORTANT - ALL Auction checks will be held ten days after close of Fair. With the exception of any animal found to have

residues in tissues of carcass. If the Weight Champion is chosen as Grand Champion or Reserve Champion, then the Reserve Weight Champion or 2nd place in the class will be allowed to sell. In the case of the Grand Champion and the Reserve Champion holding both the 1st and 2nd place in the same weight class; the 3rd place animal of any weight class will NOT move up to sell.

MARKET SMALL ANIMALS

Junior Poultry Market Broiler and Junior Rabbit Grand Champions, Reserve Champions Meat Pen/Market broiler and 1st place Weight Champion (poultry only) in each class to sell at the Junior Livestock Auction for no more than three lots total sold.

RESIDUE AVOIDANCE PROGRAM

The Monterey County Fair reserves the right to test any animal of- ficially entered in any division, for foreign substance including drugs, chemicals or feed additives. As a prior condition to accepting an en- try, a certificate of Medication form from the center of book signed by the exhibitor, Agriculture Science Instructor, 4-H Leader, Parent or Legal Guardian grants the Monterey County Fair permission to test entry.

Animals testing positive to an unapproved foreign substance includ- ing drugs, chemicals or feed additives, will be disqualified and de- clared ineligible. Carcass of disqualified animal will be disposed of per written instructions from USDA or FDA. If entry is disqualified, no changes will be made in the placing of the other animals and the owner and members of his/her immediate family will not be eligible to compete in future Monterey County Fair programs.

If foreign substance residues including drugs, chemicals or feed ad- ditives are found in tissues of carcass of animals sold through the Junior Livestock Auction Sale , the Monterey County Fair will in no way be liable or responsible for conditions of carcass or sale price of animals. If, for any reason, any part of a carcass must be removed by USDA inspectors, sale price will be discounted accordingly.
