This does not apply to San Benito and Santa Cruz County exhibitors.

16. IMPORTANT - ALL Auction checks will be held ten days after close of Fair. With the exception of any animal found to have residues in tissues of carcass. Checks will be PICKED UP at the Fair Administration Office by the club/chapter's COMMUNITY LEADER or FFA ADVISOR (The Fair Office must have that person's name on their Leader and Advisor List) ten days after close of Fair, Friday, August 28, 2009. ALL JLA & Trophy Sponsor Thank You notes must be turned in on Sunday, August 16, 2009 between 3:00 pm and 5:00 pm at the Auction Ring. All Auction Thanks You notes must have been turned in to receive checks. All premium and auction checks must be cashed within 90 days; there will be a replacement fee of \$25 plus bank fees for each check. The Monterey County Fair Junior Livestock Auction Committee discourages exhibitors from giving alcohol as a buyers' gift.

RECORDED GRADE DAIRY GOAT BY PUREBRED SIRE

DEPARTMENTAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. This show is governed by ADGA Rules.
2. For Dress Code Requirements see Junior Department Rules
3. There will be a health check this year by Department Chair.
4. No wethers or bucks are allowed on the Fairground. NO GOATS ARE TO LEAVE THE GROUNDS PRIOR TO RELEASE!
5. Any Dairy Goat determined to be unfit by Department Chairperson and Livestock Chairperson must be removed from Fairground immediately. Only animals with a "Certificate of Registry" (BLUE BORDER) issued by the American Dairy Goat Association and animals with a "Certificate of Registration of Purebred" issued by the American Goat Society are eligible.
6. Ownership deadline is June 13, 2009.
7. No bedding provided. Bed with straw only.
8. Do NOT put milk in wash racks or drains.
9. No Bucks, No Kids, unless they are nursing. Nursing kids can not be over 2 months of age. Please write the number of nursing kids you are bringing on entry form.
10. Refer to Local Rules regarding milking of exhibitors animals.
11. All goats must be milked at 9:00 p.m., Monday August 11th, Official milk out.
12. Registered and grade goats cannot be combined to show.
13. Pre-entry for Showmanship is Mandatory.
14. Due to the high cost of animal waste disposal, there will be a \$3.00 fee assessed per animal/exhibit with a maximum of \$30.00 if an exhibitor has more than 10 animals.
15. All Monterey County 4-H, FFA, and Independent Livestock Exhibitors at the Monterey County Fair MUST enter at least one (1) non-livestock project for exhibit in the 4-H, FFA Divisions in

DEPARTMENTAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. A permanent ear tag or tattoo number is required and must be shown on entry blank.
2. Animals with a Certificate of Registration (BROWN BORDER) with Purebred Sire named are eligible.
3. Animals with "Certificate of Registration" (BLUE BORDER) issued by the American Dairy Goat Association are not eligible, except experimental breed.
4. Animals with a "Certificate of Registration Purebred" issued by the American Goat Society are not eligible because only purebred animals are registered by the Society.

GROUPS

11. DAM AND PRODUCE: One entry per exhibitor.

 13. DAIRY HERD: Three does in milk. One entry per exhibitor.

3. AGES REQUIRED FOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES IS THE EXHIBITOR'S AGE ON THE DATE OF THE SHOWMANSHIP CLASS.
4. Exhibitor Age Requirements: 4-H Age Requirements: The levels of membership for 4-H are age and/or grade based. Exhibitors must be 9 years old or in the 4th Grade by January 1, 2009. See Junior Livestock Department Rules, NEW Exhibitor Age Requirements.

CLASS:

1. 4-H NOVICE - Exhibitor must have never shown this species of animal in a showmanship class at any Fair. Exhibitor must be 9 - 11 years of age and have never shown this specie.
2. 4-H JUNIOR - Exhibitor who is 9 - 13 years of age who have shown this species of animal at the Fair and for exhibitors 12 - 13 years of age who have never shown this species of animal at any Fair.
3. 4-H SENIOR - Exhibitors age 14 - 19 years of age who have previously shown this species of animal in showmanship and including exhibitors 14 - 19 years of age who have never shown this species of animal in showmanship.
4. FFA NOVICE - Exhibitor must have never shown this species of animal in a showmanship class at any Fair.
5. FFA SENIOR - Exhibitor must have shown this species of animal at any previous Fair.
