DEPARTMENTAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. This Show is governed by AMGA Rules
2. For Dress Code Requirements see Junior Department Rules
3. There will be a health check this year performed by the Department Chair.
4. No bucks are allowed on the Fairgrounds NO GOATS ARE TO LEAVE THE GROUNDS PRIOR TO RELEASE!
5. Any Meat Goat determined to be unfit by Department Chairperson and Livestock Chairperson must be removed from Fairgrounds immediately.
6. Ownership deadline is June 13, 2009.
7. No bedding provided. Bed with straw only.
8. Pre-entry for Showmanship is Mandatory.
9. Due to the high cost of animal waste disposal, there will be a \$3.00 fee assessed per animal/exhibit with a maximum of \$30.00 if an exhibitor has more than 10 animals.
10. Certificate of Animal Medication must be presented at weigh-in.
11. Outstanding Goat Exhibitor will be chosen, see: Dairy Goats
12. All Monterey County 4-H, FFA, and Independent Livestock Exhibitors at the Monterey County Fair MUST enter at least one (1) non-livestock project for exhibit in the 4-H, FFA Divisions in the junior Buildings at this year's annual Fair. All non-livestock projects must be entered and delivered on their specific dates(see page 60). NO LIVESTOCK PROJECTS WILL BE ACCEPTED IF THIS ABOVE RULE IS NOT MET. ANIMALS WILL BE SENT HOME. NO EXCEPTIONS. All other rules stated in the premium book apply. This does not apply to San Benito and Santa Cruz County exhibitors.

13. IMPORTANT - ALL Auction checks will be held ten days after close of Fair. With the exception of any animal found to have residues in tissues of carcass. Checks will be PICKED UP at the Fair Administration Office by the club/chapter's COMMUNITY LEADER or FFA ADVISOR (The Fair Office must have that person's name on their Leader and Advisor List) ten days after close of Fair, Friday, August 28, 2009. ALL JLA & Trophy Sponsor Thank You notes must be turned in on Sunday, August 16, 2009 between 3:00 pm and 5:00 pm at the Auction Ring. All Auction Thanks You notes must have been turned in to receive checks. All premium and auction checks must be cashed within 90 days; there will be a replacement fee of \$25 plus bank fees for each check. The Monterey County Fair Junior Livestock Auction Committee discourages exhibitors from giving alcohol as a buyers' gift.

OUTSTANDING GOAT EXHIBITOR

An outstanding Goat Exhibitor will be chosen and awarded on the following basis:

1. Sportsmanship
2. Helpfulness, sharing knowledge with other exhibitors and spectators.
3. Attitude toward other exhibitors and leaders.
4. Personal appearance, care, cleanliness of animals and exhibit area.
5. Overall placement in various competition.
6. Both Dairy and Market Goat combined.

DEPARTMENTAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Only Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion and the 1st place (Weight Champion) animal of each class will be allowed to sell at the 2009 Junior Livestock Auction. If the Weight Champion is chosen as Grand Champion or Reserve Champion, then the Reserve Weight Champion or 2nd place in the class will be allowed to sell. In the case of the Grand Champion and the Reserve Champion holding both the 1st and 2nd place in the same weight class; the 3rd place animal of any weight class will NOT move up to sell.
2. MARKET ANIMALS must be groomed and bathed and arrive in show condition.
3. NO FORCE FEEDING OR WATERING.
4. NO ARTIFICIAL COLORING of body of animal will be allowed. Hooves may be polished or blackened. Infraction of this rule will result in disqualification.
5. WETHERS AND DOES, any breed or crossbred goat less than 12 months of age showing teeth. All breeds judged together. Goats

must be disbudded or dehorned, no horns will be allowed.

- 6. Market Goats must remain in assigned pen.
- 7. Danish system of judging.
- 8. Weigh - in at 5:30 p.m. August 11, 2009 at the sheep scale.

MARKET GOAT (CHEVON) SCORECARD GRADE-

Market Ready: USDA Prime or Choice quality with 12th rib back fat range .08 - .12 most desirable, .13 -.22 back fat acceptable, average or greater conformation and cutability.

GRADE-NOT MARKET READY: Good or lower quality grade with 12th rib back fat range <.08 - >.22; underfinished goats grading USDA good or lower, below average conformation and cutability.

- 1. 4-H NOVICE - Exhibitor must have never shown this species of animal in a showmanship class at any Fair. Exhibitor must be 9 - 11 years of age and have never shown this specie.
- 2. 4-H JUNIOR - Exhibitor who is 9 - 13 years of age who have shown this species of animal at the Fair and for exhibitors 12 - 13 years of age who have never shown this species of animal at any Fair.
- 3. 4-H SENIOR - Exhibitors age 14 - 19 years of age who have previously shown this species of animal in showmanship and including exhibitors 14 - 19 years of age who have never shown this species of animal in showmanship.
- 4. FFA NOVICE - Exhibitor must have never shown this species of animal in a showmanship class at any Fair.
- 5. FFA SENIOR - Exhibitor must have shown this species of animal at any previous Fair.
