DEPARTMENTAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All animals must arrive in show condition.
- 4-H and FFA Breeding classes will be judged together.
- Sows and Junior Yearling Pigs or older must have raised a litter of pigs to be eligible for entry.
- Gilts entered in the Market and Feeder Hog divisions may not be entered in the Breeding Divisions or vice versa. Any violation of this rule will exclude the offending exhibitor from competition in all Departments of the Fair.
- DRAW EAR NOTCHINGS ON ENTRY FORM. DO NOT USE NUMBERS TO IDENTIFY NOTCHINGS.
- No bedding provided. Bed with straw or shavings.
- Pre-entry for showmanship is mandatory.
- Due to the high cost of animal waste disposal, there will be a \$3.00 fee assessed per animal/exhibit with a maximum of \$30.00 if an exhibitor has more than 10 animals.
- All Monterey County 4-H, FFA, and Independent Livestock Exhibitors at the Monterey County Fair MUST enter at least one (1) non-livestock project for exhibit in the 4-H, FFA Divisions in the Junior Buildings at this year's annual Fair. All non-livestock projects must be entered and delivered on their specific dates (see page 60). NO LIVESTOCK PROJECTS WILL BE ACCEPTED IF THIS ABOVE RULE IS NOT MET. ANIMALS WILL BE SENT HOME. NO EXCEPTIONS. All other rules stated in the premium book apply. This does not apply to San Benito and Santa Cruz County exhibitors.
- IMPORTANT - ALL Auction checks will be held ten days after close of Fair. With the exception of any animal found to have residues in tissues of carcass. Checks will be PICKED UP at the Fair Administration Office by the club/chapter's COMMUNITY

GROUPS

- YOUNG HERD: One boar, three (3) sows, not over Fall Pig Age (July 1, 2007 - December 31, 2007). All owned by one exhibitor and entered in group entries must be of one breed.
- GET OF SIRE: Four (4) animals, any age by same sire. All owned by one exhibitor.
- BEST PAIR: Either sex, January Pigs (January 1, 2008 through January 31, 2008) or younger, owned by one exhibitor.

UNREGISTERED PUREBRED GRADE OR CROSSBRED SWINE BY PURE- BRED SIRE

DEPARTMENTAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- By his signature as the owner or agent on any entry form, the exhibitor also certifies that the sire of each animal entered in the following classes for grade animals was either registered or purebred.
- A PERMANENT EAR TAG OR TATTOO NUMBER OR EAR NOTCHING IS REQUIRED AND MUST BE SHOWN ON ENTRY FORM.

DEPARTMENTAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- OWNERSHIP REQUIREMENT DATE: June 13, 2009.
- NOTICE: The use of stimulants or depressants will not be permitted. This includes "show paste." The manager or department chairman will have the right to refuse any animal considered too wild for the safety of all concerned. Such animals will be removed from the Fairgrounds.
Monterey County Fair Jr. Livestock Auction is a TERMINAL SALE; all animals judged market acceptable will be sold through the auction.
- After weighing, market hogs may be divided into weight lots within the specified limitation as desired for convenience in judging.
- ALL BREEDS JUDGED TOGETHER.
- SWINE TO BE WASHED IN WASH RACKS ONLY
- The Danish System of Judging will be used.
- One tack box for every two exhibitors.
- OVERWEIGHT ANIMALS will NOT be allowed to show at the 2009 Monterey County Fair. All overweight market hogs must be removed from the Fairgrounds by 7:00 p.m. on Weigh In Day,

Tuesday, August 11, 2009.

- It is mandatory that a "Certificate of Animal Medication" be completed for each market animal. This form is located at the rear of the book.
- No first bedding provided. Bed with straw or shavings.
- All market and feeder animals must include sellers name on entry. Have bill of sale available.
- Pre-entry for showmanship is mandatory.
- Independent junior exhibitors refer to Junior Livestock Department Rule 9.

MARKET HOGS SCORECARD

GRADE – MARKET ACCEPTABLE:

U.S. No. 1 and No. 2 hogs of average or greater conformation that are acceptable in leanness, muscularity and production traits.

GRADE – NOT MARKET ACCEPTABLE:

Any hog of below average conformation including U.S. number 3, U.S. number 4 and utility grade hogs.

DEPARTMENTAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Pre-entry for Showmanship is mandatory.
2. Top three winners of each class may progress and compete only if there is a showmanship class offered. Top 3 novices go to the Junior Final and top 3 juniors go into the Senior Final.
3. Top five winners of 4-H Senior and FFA Senior Showmanship for SHEEP, SWINE AND BEEF ONLY may progress and compete in Master Showmanship competition. The top five 4-H Senior and top 5 FFA Senior will show together; one Master Showman will be chosen
4. See showmanship Rules and Regulations.
5. AGES REQUIRED FOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES IS THE EXHIBITORS' AGE ON THE DATE OF THE SHOWMANSHIP CLASS.
6. Exhibitor Age Requirements: 4-H Age Requirements: The levels of membership for 4-H are age and/or grade based. Exhibitors must be 9 years old or in the 4th Grade by January 1, 2009. See Junior Livestock Department Rules, NEW Exhibitor Age Requirements.

CLASS:

1. 4-H NOVICE -Exhibitor must be 9 - 11 years of age and have never shown this specie before at any Fair.
2. 4-H JUNIOR - Exhibitor who is 9 - 13 years of age who have shown this species of animal at the Fair and for exhibitors 12 - 13 years of age who have never shown this species of animal at any Fair.
3. 4-H SENIOR - Exhibitors age 14 - 19 years of age who have previously shown this species of animal in showmanship and including exhibitors 14 - 19 years of age who have never shown this species of animal in showmanship.
4. FFA NOVICE - Exhibitor must have never shown this species of animal in a showmanship class at any Fair
5. FFA SENIOR - Exhibitor must have shown this species of animal at any previous Fair.
