



## Monterey Bay Classic General Show Rules



1. All Steer, hog, lamb and goat exhibitors must be 19 years old and under as of January 1, 2012. All Heifer exhibitors must be 21 years old and under as of January 1, 2012.
2. **All paper entries must be postmarked by Monday, March 12, 2012 to avoid any late entry fees of \$25.00 per head. New this year, enter and pay online through Thursday, March 22, 2012 with no late fees simply visit [www.montereycountyfair.com/mbc](http://www.montereycountyfair.com/mbc).**
3. Entry Fees:
  - Steers/ Heifers- \$40/ head
  - Sheep -\$30/ head
  - Swine-\$30/ head
  - Goat-\$ 30/ head
  - Showmanship \$10/ Entry (Limit one per species)
  - **Late Entry Forms will be accepted by mail postmarked after Monday, March 12 as well as on the spot entries at weigh-in. All late entries will be charged an additional fee of \$25.00 per head!**
  - **ABSOLUTELY NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.**
4. The show management reserves the right to disqualify any animal and the exhibitor of the animal if the animal has been fitted or treated in an unethical manner. Entry fees will not be refunded and all awards and premiums will be withheld from the exhibitor.
5. The show management reserves the right to change the show schedule and classes to improve the show.
6. The Monterey Bay Classic, Monterey County Fair, and those associated with the show will assume no responsibility for death or injury to livestock or persons during the show. The above will also not be responsible or liable for damage of property or stolen items.
7. Class premiums will be paid by check based on a percentage on the day of the show.
8. A \$20.00 fee will be charged for any unclean pens.
9. Species will be released after their respective shows and after their stalls have been cleaned. All exhibitors must check with show officials to be released from the show.
10. Exhibitors are responsible for bringing their own bedding. Bedding and feed will be available for purchase.
11. Consumption of alcoholic beverages by exhibitors is prohibited at all times!!
12. **ALL SHEEP AND GOATS may be inspected prior to off loading!** Animals showing evidence of the Callipyge gene (Heavy muscled) in their conformation will **NOT BE ALLOWED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS**. They will not be allowed to off load and must be removed immediately. This rule

includes all sheep or goats in that load. This rule also applies to any animals showing evidence of Club Lamb Fungus Disease.

**13. Heifer Registration and Transportation papers will be due at check-in. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS!**

**14. NEW - All Steer Exhibitors will BE REQUIRED TO HAVE REGISTRATION PAPERS VERIFYING PARENTAGE AND PEDIGREE in order to be shown in the English Steer Division at any CJLA sanctioned steer show. These registration papers must be official purebred steer registration papers from the respective national breed association. English Steers (Angus, Hereford or Shorthorn) must be registered in EXHIBITORS NAME AND papers must be presented to show management prior to exhibition for verification at all CJLA shows.**

**15. Dogs on the fairgrounds must be on a leash at all times.**

**16.** R.V. spaces with full hookups are available at the Monterey County Fairgrounds for \$40 per night. No livestock will be allowed in the R.V. camping area. For R.V. Reservations, please call Julius at (831) 657-9347.

**17.** All exhibitors must show their own animal. The only exception granted will be if an exhibitor has more than one entry in a class.

**18. Hog Show Rules:**

- Classes determined and posted after weigh in.
- No health papers required.
- All breeds and genders will be shown together.
- Show Management reserves the right to refuse entries if animal is of questionable health or quality.

**19. Goat Show Rules:**

- Classes determined and posted after weigh in.
- The Show Management reserves the right to refuse entries if animal is of questionable health or quality

**20. Sheep Show Rules:**

- Classes determined and posted after weigh in.
- All breeds and genders will be shown together.
- The Show Management reserves the right to refuse entries if animal is of questionable health or quality.

**21. Steer Show Rules:**

- Classes determined and posted after weigh in according to CJLA guidelines.
- The Show Management reserves the right to refuse entries if animal is of questionable health or quality

**22. Heifer Show Rules:**

- Classes determined and posted after check in according to CJLA guidelines.

- The Show Management reserves the right to refuse entries if animal is of questionable health or quality
- Exhibitors must check in registration and transportation papers.
- Grade Heifer Class (Non-Registered Heifers), need breed of sire and dam listed on entry form in lieu of name and registration number.
- Cow Calf Class in all breeds, cows of any age are eligible.

### 23. Showmanship Rules:

- Entry fee \$10 per division.
- No uniforms required
- Animal and exhibitor must have competed together in class to be eligible for showmanship.
- **Beef showmanship classes will combine heifers and steers.**
- **All exhibitors must show their own animals. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- Sheep, Goats, Steer and Swine, showmanship divisions will be broken as follows:
  - Junior (9-12)
  - Intermediate (13-15)
  - Senior (16-19)
- Heifer showmanship divisions will be broken as follows
  - Junior (9-12)
  - Intermediate (13-15)
  - Senior (16-21)

### 24. Champion & Premium Money Payouts

- Showmanship premiums for all species will be:

  - iii. 3<sup>rd</sup> Place - \$5.00
