

#### **Come to the Sale:**

On August 30th, come to the sale and select the animal(s) of your choice and do your own bidding. You may have your animal(s) processed for your freezer or arranged for resale at market price (see Bid/Resale below).

#### Place an Order:

Contact Kelly Violini, Auction Chair, with the enclosed form, or call her at (831) 372-5863. The Committee will bid on an animal at your stipulated price.

#### **Payment:**

Now accepting payments day of! Pay with your credit card, check, or cash before you leave.

### **Bid/Resale:**

If you want to participate in helping but you have no need for meat, the Auction Buyers Committee will resell the animal at market price. You pay only the difference between the sale price and the current market price. This "premium" amount has been accepted by the IRS as a deductible expense.
